### **Abstract**

The purposes of this research were to study the quality of working life and the relationship between variables such as personal factors, professional value, job & management factors and quality of working life of nursing personnel at the third army region hospital, the sample consisted of 240 nursing personnel selected through stratified random sampling technique. The instrument was questionnaire developed by the researcher, using Walton's criteria of working life. Data were analyzed by descriptive statistics, mean population at the 95% level of confident, Pearson's product moment correlation and Cramer's V correlation.

The results of the study revealed that :

1. The over all quality of working life of the nursing personnel at the third army region hospital was at the moderate level .
2. The relationship between position, department, hospital that they work, professional value, job and management factors and quality of working life were statistically significant at the level of .05.
