#### **Abstract**

The study on this title is objectified to study the factors affecting decision making of Chiang Mai Police in casting their ballots in the last senatorial election.

The study uses questionnaires to collect data and information for the research. The study's samples are police officers who are stationed in the following districts :MaeRim, Mae Taeng, Chiang Dao, Chai Prakan, Fang and from the Provincial Chiang Mai Police Headquarter.

The study finds that :

1. Age factor has no impact on decision in choosing candidates.
2. Educational factor has impact on decision in choosing candidates.
3. Occupational factor has impact on decision in choosing candidates.
4. Economic status factor has correlationship towards choosing candidates of the same occupation.
5. Rankings have impact on decision in choosing the candidates.
6. Duty assignment has correlationship towards choosing candidates.

The prime recommendation of the study is that, in order to conduct a fair and just election, candidates who have military or police ranks should not use their rank prefixes before their names.
