

Independent Study Title Opinions of Workplace Division Heads on
Students Training from Chiang Mai Lanna
Polytechnic School

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Abstract

The purposes of this investigation were to study opinions of workplace division heads on student training from Chiang Mai Lanna Polytechnic School with respect to academic ability, personality and personal characteristics, techniques, skills and working method, and vocational attitude. The population under study comprised 65 workplace division heads working at various organizations where the forementioned school had sent its students to fulfill the training requirement in the 1996 academic year. The instrument used was rating scale questionnaire. The collected data were analyzed through applications of percentage, mean and standard deviation.

The findings could be summarized as follows :

Workplace division heads expressed their opinions in "the fair level" concerning students' academic ability, techniques, skills and working method ; whereas, personality and personal characteristics, and vocational attitude were revealed in "the good level" by the division heads.
