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Independent Study Title	Opinions Towards Workshop Environments of Lampang Technical College Students
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Abstract

The purpose of this research was to study opinions towards workshop environments of Lampang Technical College students according to four independent factors : major programs, levels of certificate, native home, parents' economic status.

The research sample was 470 Lampang Technical College students studying in certificate vocational and diploma vocational level. They were selected by using stratified random sampling from 6 departments. The research instrument was a questionnaire asking opinions and suggestions concerning the workshop environments. The statistical analyses included percentage, mean, standard deviation, One-Way Analysis of Variance and Scheffe Test.

The results were as follows :-

1. The students perceived that the workshops had enough illumination for practical training, good smoke ventilation, and also a suitable fire protection. Nonetheless, there should be toilets and washbasins within the workshops and waste water treatment system. The problem found were : the rubbish disposal system from each workshop has caused the environmental pollution ; there were not enough practical training devices and some of them were not safe for operating.

2. When comparing the difference of the students' opinions according to the independent variables, it found that :-

2.1 Opinions towards workshop environments among students majoring in different programs were significantly different at .05 level. The pairwise comparisons of means using Scheffe's test revealed that opinions towards workshop environments

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between machanic and construction students were significantly different at .05 level. There was no difference among the rest pairs.

2.2 Opinions towards workshop environments between students with different levels of certificate were significantly different at .05 level.

2.3 Opinions towards workshop environments among students with different native home were not significantly different.

2.4 Opinions towards workshop environments among students with different parents' economic status were not significantly different.

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
