CHAPTER VI

CONCLUSIONS

The following conclusions were drawn from this investigation:

The following conclusions can be made from this investigation:

- 1. Maxillary arch dimensions of patients with complete unilateral cleft lip and palate at 9 years of age who undergone one-stage and two-stage surgical closure were not significantly different in anterior ach width and posterior arch width.
- 2. Dental arch relationships were not significantly different in anterior overjet, anterior overbite, anterior crossbite and posterior crossbite.

However a final verification of the treatment protocol employed in the Cleft team will only be possible after the completion of maxillary growth.
